
The Specialist & Scientist GROW Programme

Step one:

Apply Online

Step three:

Assessment Centre

You will be required to complete a group activity. You will also have the chance to network with current Early Careers employees.


Step four:

Interview


The final interview is made up of two parts. Firstly, we will assess your competencies, behaviours, and suitability for the position. Part 2 focuses on your technical knowledge.




